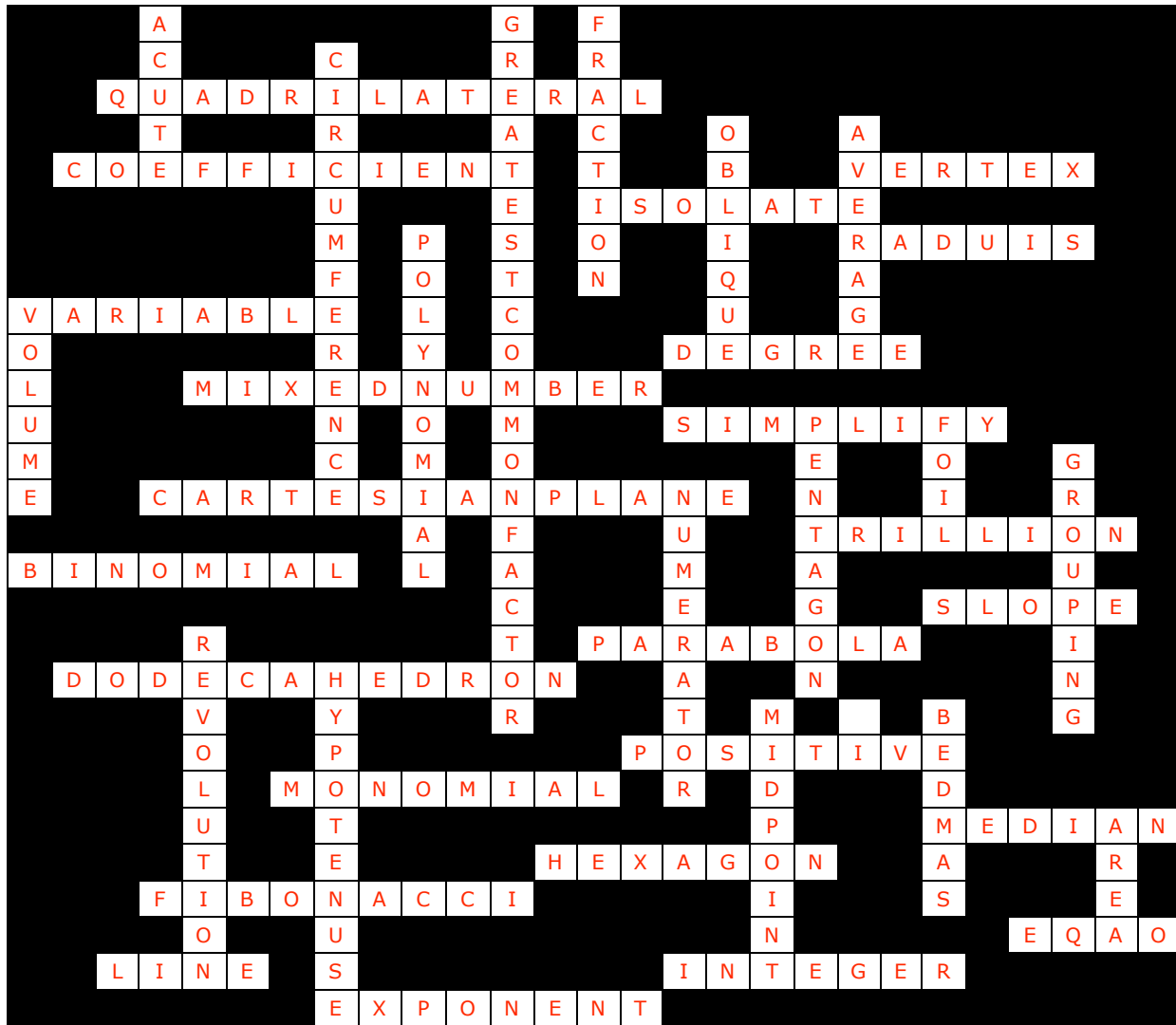


GLOSSARY CROSSWORD PUZZLE
