


## How to search for SmartBoard resources in the OERB

**Note:** All resources in the OERB can be displayed on interactive white boards, including SmartBoards. All of the interactive content, such as the thousands of interactive games in the OERB can be used interactively on interactive whiteboards.

Many resources created using the Notebook software for SmartBoards have been contributed to the OERB over the last few months. On October 27, 2010 there are currently 578.


Here is how you can search for SmartBoard resources in the OERB:

1. Login to the OERB at <http://resources.elearningontario.ca> – use your board userid and password (if you do not know what that account is, ask your school. If they do not know, contact us at [eLo@ontario.ca](mailto:ELo@ontario.ca))
2. Click on **Search**
3. Click on **Advanced Search**
4. In the first row of search fields, select **File Format** from the drop down menu on the far right.



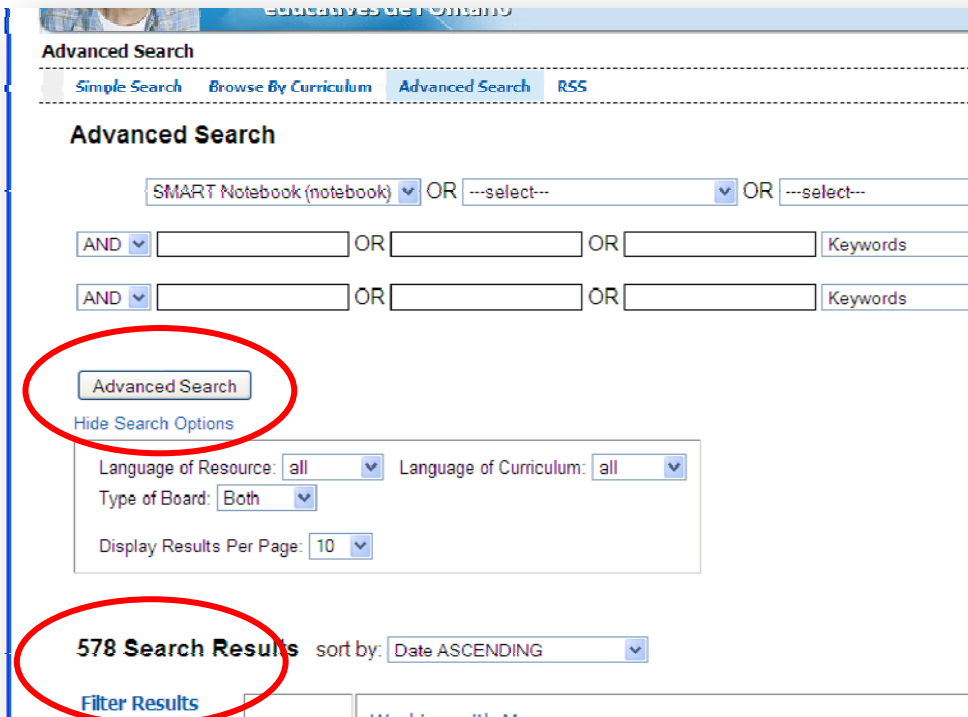

7. To narrow your search, you can use the second and third row. For example, if you only wanted to find SmartBoard resources for Algebra, you could enter **Algebra** in the second row as a keyword:
