

ATTENDANCE/ WORK COMPLETION REQUIREMENT

Course material is covered in a short period of time in Summer School; therefore it is very important that online attendance be made a priority. Students who miss more than 3 days, or do not complete course work as assigned will be removed from the course. ALL course work must be completed within the Summer School timelines (July 4 – July 28, 2016). **Students, and their families must ensure that jobs, holidays and other activities do not jeopardize student enrolment status.**

Online courses require a time commitment of 5+ hours a day.

All Summer School credits are granted subject to confirmation of eligibility by the home school. Students must ensure that all admission requirements have been met.
